3. Nominations papers must be delivered to the (Acting) Returning Officer at Public Service Plaza, Civic Centre Road, Havant, Hampshire, PO9 2AX on any day after the date of this notice between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm but no later than **4 pm on Friday, 7th June 2024**.
4. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as banker in the United Kingdom or, with the (Acting) Returning Officer's consent, in any other manner (including by debit or credit card or the electronic transfer of funds).
5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 4th July 2024**

New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Public Service Plaza, Civic Centre Road, Havant, Hampshire, PO9 2AX by **5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024**.
